# **Our Mission Statement**

The Leamington Mennonite Home & Apartments aim to provide the best possible physical, emotional, and spiritual continuum of care for the elderly and others needing special support in a community setting. We provide resources for persons to enjoy a healthy, fulfilling retirement in addition to restorative and maintenance health care within the spirit of Christian love and compassion.

## **Retirement Residence**

Our Retirement Residence consists of one floor with 45 Standard Resident and 4 Respite Care Rooms. The resident area has its own dining room, as well as lounges, an auditorium, and tub and shower rooms.

Nursing Staff and Personal Support Workers are available for the personal and medical needs of our residents 24/7. Home-cooked meals are provided three times a day with snacks in between.



We aim to care for our residents' social needs as well – we regularly schedule activities to provide them will structured social interaction. Some of these activities include exercises, Movie Night, Coffee Club, group outings, and musical performances.

## **Admission Process**

No Ministry of Health assessment or eligibility is required for our Retirement Residence. Individuals seeking application for a Retirement Residence bed should be cognitively well and able to look after their activities of daily living, including eating and toileting. Medications and treatments are provided by Registered Nursing Staff and



personal assistance is provided for bathing and dressing as needed.

When residents can no longer look after these activities of daily living, the Nursing Staff and

Director of Care will assess the resident's need for Long Term Care. We assist Retirement residents and their families in completing the required documentation for Long Term Care and will liaise with the *Erie St. Clair LHIN*, which determines all admissions to Long Term Care facilities, including those for our Home.

# **Respite Care**

Respite Care is meant for individuals who temporarily require assistance with daily activities of living, such as bathing, dressing, and toileting. Our Respite Care rate is \$100 per day, which includes all nursing and personal support, dietary, housekeeping, and laundry needs.

## What We Provide

**Personal:** We provide our residents with bed sheets, linens, bedspreads, towels, and some personal hygiene products such as toothpaste, soap, and shaving cream. All clothing should be labelled by our Housekeeping Department before use. Please ensure that all new clothing is first brought to the Front Office or Nurse Station for labelling to avoid any misplacing of resident clothing.

Furnishings: We provide our residents with a bed, night table, and dresser — families may wish



to bring some additional furnishings depending on available space. Cable hookup is provided through the Front Office should residents wish to bring a television. Telephone installation and payment is the responsibility of the resident and/or family members.
